

Nash Box Logic Tackle Box

I haven't used a tackle box for some years now as I have been using the Nash Rig Wallet, but after seeing the Nash Box Logic Tackle Box I thought I would try it. It's well made with a rig rule embedded in the plastic lid but what I really like is that all the compartments inside can be adjusted to my preference and it fits snugly on my Box Logic Bivvy Table. To complement the Tackle Box Nash has made an array of smaller boxes that fit inside, and some are really handy. My favourite is the Choddy Box – what a bit of kit this is! It holds your chod rigs on a small revolving rubberised roller inside the box so when you come to use one you've loaded into it, the rig has a perfect curve. There are also two compartment boxes and an additional four compartments which will hold all manner of small items. The Nash Box Logic Tackle Box retails at £19.99 for the large version and £14.99 for the small. For more information visit www.nashtackle.co.uk.

You must appreciate that the 'Thinking Tackle' series is produced by a company that also produces end tackle components, so this is a vehicle to promote its products. Once you're fully aware of that, you can then start to neutralize all the plugging and actually take on board all the advice that's being offered.

The 420-minute, three-disk set is broken down into nine entertaining shows and offers excellent value at

just £19.99, especially when you consider the quality of the content.


